



Wind Instrument Scale Requirements

All wind instrument solo events (except trombone) will be asked to perform one chromatic scale and one major scale. Treble clef baritones should use the Bb instrument scales, Bass clef baritones should use the C instrument scales. Trombonists will be asked to play two major scales. The scales performers may be asked (by classification) are:

String soloists will be asked to perform two major scales to be selected from the following:
