- All members of the front ensemble are responsible for having their 5th grade bell kit and bringing it in for use in the 3 parades we do throughout the year. We will supply the marching harness however the student is responsible for supplying their 5th grade bell kit.
- All members of the Cymbal line must purchase cymbal gloves/batting gloves that will be specified by the drum staff
- All members of the pit/battery are responsible for purchasing the necessary marching sticks/mallets to be utilized in the current season. Because of the extended use, wear and tear, and exposure to the elements, the life of marching sticks/mallets is typically only 1 season.
- All Percussionists are required **to still own and have in good condition** all of their equipment from the middle school percussion. **EVERY member of the percussion section is required to have their own: stick bag, Concert Snare Sticks, Yarn mallets, hard rubber mallets, hard plastic mallets, brass mallets, timpani mallets, and triangle beater.**
- All students should label their supplies with their name and LOCK UP their materials at all times – the band staff assumes no responsibility for lost/damaged/stolen sticks or mallets that have not been properly locked up
- **Once the school year begins, All members of the Battery must attend Battery Sectionals, Every Thursday from 2:30-3:30 before reporting to their fall sport practice**
